

Minehead Literary Festival Short Story Competition 2020 Rules and Entry Form 16+

By entering the 16+ Minehead Literary Festival 2020 Short Story Competition, you agree to abide by the following rules:

Entrants must be over 16-years-old.

Entries must be typed in English and be the exclusive work of the entrant.

The entrant's name must only appear on this entry form and not on the entry itself. We will not share your details with anyone else.

Entries must not be currently entered in any other competition and not have been previously self-published, broadcast, or accepted for publication.

Entries may be in the form of prose – fiction and non-fiction – poetry, haiku or play. Entries must not exceed more than 500 words. Only one entry per person.

Entries cannot be returned, so entrants should retain their own copy.

Entries may be submitted by email to mineheadliteraryfestival@gmail.com, or posted to Minehead Literary Festival (Comp), c/o Flat 1 Merton Place, Western Lane, Minehead TA24 8BG. Email entries will be acknowledged, but postal entries will only be acknowledged if a stamped, self-addressed envelope is enclosed.

Shortlisted entrants will be notified week beginning Monday 13th Friday April 10, 2020.

The Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
